New Ordinance - No. 185

B.Ed. (Semester System)

(Bachelor of Education)

Approved in the Coordination meeting on .....

### 1. Eligibility:

- 1.1 Candidates with at least 50% marks either in Bachelor's Degree and/ or in the Master's degree in Science/Social Sciences/Humanities, Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55 % marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto are eligible for admission to the programme.
- 1.2 The reservation and other relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the prevailing rules of the State Government.

#### 2. Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination and/or in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the State Government and the University.

#### 3. Duration:

The B.Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic years, consisting of four semesters which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme.

#### 4.. Attendance:

In the theory and practical papers attendance of student-teachers must be 80% and in internship is should be 90%. The relaxation can be availed as specified in the Ordinance 6 of this university.

## 5. Assessment:

The examination shall consists of two parts, namely

Part- I - Theory and

Part-II Practical/ Internal Assessment in each semester

The classification and division in theory (Part- I) will be as under-

1<sup>st</sup> Division 60% and above marks
2<sup>nd</sup> Division 45% and above but less than 60% marks
3<sup>rd</sup> Division 33% and above but less than 45% marks

Fail Below 33%

In each theory paper the candidate should obtain a minimum of 25% marks.

The classification and division in practical (Part- II) (A+B) will be as under

1<sup>st</sup> Division 80% and above marks
2<sup>nd</sup> Division 60% and above but less than 80%

marks

3<sup>rd</sup> Division

50% and

50% and above but less than 60%

marks

Fail Below 50%

The Theory papers in each semester should have five categories, such as core contemporary studies, pedagogic, teacher enrichment and Elective. In each semester a candidate should obtain 33% marks of aggregate in theory papers and 50% in practical, separately.

If any student fails in theory paper or in practical he/she can continue in the next semester and will be allowed to appear at the ATKT to maximum 2 times in two papers. However, one candidate has to clear all back papers in a maximum duration of three years from the date of admission.

- Curriculum programme implementation, syllabus, assessment and examination scheme shall be as per the NCTE norms and as approved by Board of Studies.
  - 6.1. Internal assessment of each candidate is to be carried out throughout the course and cumulative record of each candidate is to be maintained.
  - 6.2. School internship will be for a minimum duration of 20 weeks (4 weeks in the first two semester and 16 weeks in the last two semesters. This should also include, besides practice teaching, an initial phase of one week for observing a regular classroom with a regular teacher and would also include peer observations, teacher observations and faculty observations of practice lessons in each semester.
  - 6.3. Every student has to complete practical work as per syllabus approved by Board of Studies and have to submit a practical copy record. An External Examiner will evaluate the students performance and will also take viva-voce examination.
  - 6.5. Every student has to select one school subjects of two levels for teaching practice. The details about number of lessons shall be followed as per the provisions given by the BoS.
  - 6.6. A Student shall have to opt for one elective paper out of the elective courses prescribed.

The Institution shall change fee as prescribed by the affiliating body / State Government in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulation 2002, as amended from time to time, and shall not charge donations, capitation fee etc from the students.

 The Students of one year B Ed programme will be governed by the old ordinance no. 59 of this university.
