M.Ed.Semester system

(Master of Education).

(effected from 1st July 2015)

- 1. The M.Ed. Programme shall be of a duration of two academic years including field attachment for a minimum of 4 weeks and research dissertation. Student shall be permitted to complete the Programme requirements of the two years programme within a maximum period of three years from the date of admission the programme. The summer should be used for field attachment/practicum/other activities.
- 2. Candidate seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade in the following programme-B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed.,B.Sc.B.Ed/B.El.Ed/D.El Ed from any recognized university.
- 3. Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying examination and in the entrance examination or any other selection process as per the policy of the state government/university.
- 4. The examination for the degree shall be held semester wise as decided and at centers fixed by the university.
- 5. A candidate for the M.Ed.examination shall be pursue a regular course of study in a college affiliated with this university. The minimum attendance of students shall be 80% for theory course and practicum and 90% for field attachment.
- 6. The examination shall consists of theory, practicum and dissertation as decided by the concerned Board of Studies.
- 7. For part-II of the examination of regular candidates one internal and one external examiner shall be appointed by the University. They may either award marks jointly or separately in respect of the dissertation and the Viva-Voce examination, in the later case the two examiners may award marks out of half of the maximum marks allotted to dissertation and Viva-Voce. The proposal for

dissertation should be approved by an appropriate board or similar such committee.

- In order to be successful in the examination a candidate shall pass in both theory and practical's by obtaining not less than 36% marks of the aggregate ightharpoonupmarks obtained each semester, not less than 25% marks in any individual paper and not less than 50% of aggregate marks obtained in practical. Candidate obtaining less than 48% of the aggregate marks obtainable for collectively based on them and practical shall be placed in the III division, candidate obtaining less than 60% marks be placed in the II division and candidate obtaining 60% and above marks shall be placed in the I division. Distinction shall be awarded to the candidates who obtain 75% and above in aggregate in both the parts.
- 9. If any student fails in theory paper or in practical he/she can continue in the next semester and will be allowed to appear at the ATKT to maximum 2 times in one paper. However one candidate has to clear all back papers in maximum duration of three years from the date of admission.
- An ATKT candidate will be given two attempts to clear the failed 10. paper/practical/dissertation (main exam. + two chances).
- The Students of one year M.Ed. programme will be governed by the old 11. ordinance no. 31 of this university.
